The school soon built four outside courts. Natural Rubber was the material of choice for the ball. Students modified their racquets to have a smaller reach to play in these cramped conditions. The racquets have changed in much the same way as those used in tennis. Squash rackets used to be made out of laminated timber. In the 1980s, construction shifted to lighter, carbon-based materials (such as graphite) with small additions of such components as Kevlar, boron and titanium. Natural "gut" strings were replaced with synthetic strings. In the 20th century the game increased in popularity with various schools, clubs and even private citizens building squash courts, but with no set dimensions.
